Rome is the city that preserves the largest number of Obelisks in the world. These monuments, mostly of Egyptian origin, have no urban function and still represent an important, decorative and monumental symbol with own stories and anecdotes.

- Length about 20 km (4-5 hours).
- Difficulty: easy.
- Ability to bike for many hours and a good level of fitness are mandatory.
- Ability to ride on roads open to car traffic is required.
- **HELMET OBLIGATORY**

Price: € 30 per person to be paid directly at meeting point . A €5 special discount will be applied to those who bring other people (relatives or friends).
